

An ordinance to amend an ordinance governing the parking of motor vehicles and the construction of driveways within the Corporate limits of Fincastle, Kentucky passed on May 23, 1985, which as amended shall provide as follows:

Be it ordained by the City of Fincastle:

SECTION I

It shall be unlawful for any record owner of any lot situated within the boundaries of the city or any other person to cause or permit any motor vehicle to be parked upon any street or any other public paved areas within the city for a period in excess of two hours during any twenty-four hour period.

SECTION II

It shall be unlawful for any record owner of any lot situated within the boundaries of the city or any other person to cause or permit any motor vehicle to be parked anywhere upon any lot within the city except upon a concrete or blacktop paved driveway that is situated between the garage and the street, or within a garage attached to the house, except one factory manufactured motor home per improved lot may be parked in the yard to the rear of the house, or in the yard to the side of the house anywhere beyond 5 (five) feet behind the front of the house.

SECTION III

It shall be unlawful for any record owner of any lot situated within the boundaries of the city or any other person to cause or permit any motor vehicle to be parked in such a manner that causes any sidewalk within the city to be fully or partially blocked or otherwise impassable during the hours between 6 A.M. and 11 P.M.

SECTION IV

It shall be unlawful for the record owner of any lot situated within the boundaries of the city to construct or permit to be constructed any driveway that is in excess of 24 feet in width and which does not run directly from or adjacent to the garage to the street.

SECTION V

It shall be unlawful for the record owner of any lot within the city to construct or permit to be constructed a driveway from any material other than concrete or bituminous asphalt.

SECTION VI

It shall be unlawful for the record owner of any lot situated within the city or any other person to construct or permit to be constructed more than one driveway upon any lot within the city.

SECTION VII

It shall be unlawful for the record owner of any lot situated within the city or any other person to cause or permit an inoperable motor vehicle to be parked within the city outside a garage.

SECTION VIII

(A.) Anytime any violation of the foregoing sections occurs within a 24 hour period shall be considered one violation and any violation shall be punishable by a fine of not less than \$25.00 and not more than \$100.00

(B.) The City shall have the right to remove and impound any motor vehicle that may cause any of the foregoing sections to be violated and in addition thereto, the city shall have the right to seek and obtain any and all civil remedies which may be available to enforce any of the provisions of this ordinance.

(C.) The City may impose a lien upon the property of any property owner who fails to pay any fine which may be imposed for any violation of any sections of the within ordinance, and may require such owner to pay the cost of filing such lien and any cost for releasing such lien.
