The meeting of the City of Fincastle called to order at 6:30 pm at the Hope Evangelical Lutheran Church, 4200 Shenandoah Drive.

Present: Mayor John Bell. City Attorney Jennifer Proud. Commissioners: Ollie White, Gene Harris, Jr., James Holt, Samuel Jackson and Jerry Gregory, Treasurer/Clerk Jean Reid. The guests were city residents, the code enforcement officer and website administrator.

MINUTES

The minutes of the meeting 6-12-25 were reviewed. Commissioner Jackson moved to accept the minutes as presented, a second came from Commissioner Gregory, motion passed unanimously.

TREASURER REPORT

General Fund YTD as of 6-30-2025	\$151,777.97

All balances are from bank statements. Quickbooks price increase effective 7-23-2025 for QB Online Essentials to \$75 from current \$68.90. Checks cleared for road project payment. Treasurer Clerk gave an analysis for fiscal year end 6-30-2025. Income exceeded budget estimate in general funds, primarily from insurance premium taxes and money market interest, road fund just under projected budget estimate. Expenses were under budget for all expense categories in general fund, expended exactly what was budgeted for Road Fund and all ARPA funds were expended prior to 12-31-2024. Commissioner Gregory moved to accept the treasurer report subject to audit. A second came from Commissioner Holt, motion passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS

Current contract for police patrols from MSS expires 7-11-2025. The Mayor is waiting to hear back from them about extending the current contract.

NEW BUSINESS

Condition of premises code violations noted on two properties. Code enforcement officer directed to act with citations.

OPEN FLOOR

The Mayor called for a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Gregory moved to adjourn, a second came from Commissioner Harris, motion passed unanimously.
